By-Laws / Permits

Fire Permits

Fire permit renewal invoices will be mailed out in the early part of 2024. Any permits not paid for by the due date will be cancelled. Fire permits are required for Open Air Burning and beach fires. You must report all Open Air Burning to our toll free 24/7 Open Air Burning reporting number at 1-800-511-9911. Winter Parking By-Law

Residents are reminded that the Traffic and Parking By-Law 99-20 as amended states that parking is not allowed on any street within the Township between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 30th.

Dog Tags

All dogs in Huron-Kinloss must be registered with the Township, and tags must be attached to their collars. 2023 dog owners or new owners can purchase a tag for \$15 until February 29, 2024. Late renewals or registrants cost \$25 beginning March 01, 2024. Failing to purchase a tag incurs a \$100 fine; replacement tags cost \$10. Fill out the Dog Tag Cancellation form online if a tag is no longer needed. Tags can be purchased online by visiting huronkinloss.com/Dogs. Tags can also be purchased in person at Country Depot in Kincardine, Hodgin's Home Hardware in Lucknow, or the Township office in Ripley.

Noise Exemption

Persons having functions where loud noise will occur after 11:00 p.m. need to apply for an exemption to the Noise By-Law 2005-101 by submitting a letter to the Clerk's Department at least 6 weeks prior to the event. Fireworks are only permitted for Canada Day or Victoria Day celebrations and will need an exemption to be detonated at any other time.

Dogs Must Be Leashed

Dogs on public property, including the beach, must be on a leash not exceeding 1.8 meters. The person holding the leash must maintain full control. Dogs can be taken off leash at the designated dog park next to the Point Clark Community Centre at 344 Lake Range Dr, Point Clark.

Public Works

Garbage Collection

All garbage bags must be sealed, not weigh more than 18kg (40lbs), and have a Huron-Kinloss bag tag sticker. The price of bag tags will be increasing from \$2.50 to \$3.00 as of April 1, 2024. Bag tags are available to purchase at the Township office and various local retailers. The 2024 collection schedule for garbage and recyclables is available online at www.brucerecycling.com.

Landfill and Yard Waste Sites

Huron Landfill Site – 2087 Concession 6 East

Open Tuesdays, Fridays, Saturdays 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Closed: Fri. March 29 and Sat. March 30, 2024 for Easter.

Did you know that Huron Landfill now recycles the following:

- Bale wrap, silage bags, bunker cover, baler twine (must be in Cleanfarm bags available at the landfill)
- Electronics & batteries (no car batteries)
- Expanded polystyrene (dense Styrofoam that is found in appliance and electronics packaging, NOT insulation or food packaging)
- Household recyclables, tires
- Mattresses and box springs for a fee
- Scrap steel and appliances (freon must be removed and CFC tagged)

Fees apply for other items disposed of at the landfill. Fees will be increasing as of April 1, 2024. As per the Huron Landfill site Certificate of Approval and Waste Management By-Law 2011-09, the Township is only able to accept materials from Township sources. Proof is required when disposing of items at the landfill site.

Yard Waste Depots

2083 Concession 6 E – Just east of Huron Landfill
907 Havelock St Lucknow – Just south of soccer fields

Open seasonally from mid-April to mid-November, weather dependent. These depots will be open to the public 24/7 during this time frame. Yard Waste Depots will accept leaves, grass, brush, and small branches (under 6"). No logs or stumps!

Water Management

Our Water System Operators require at least 48 hours' notice to turn water valves off/on. Please call the Township office if this service is required. Flushing occurs in the spring and fall and is an ongoing part of water system management. The Township highly recommends that all residents install back flow preventers on all outside taps.

The Huron-Kinloss water systems supply naturally occurring hard water. If you plan on using a water softener, please see our website for the hardness level in your area to set your softener correctly. Huron-Kinloss water systems indicate the presence of Sodium Chloride, Fluoride, and Barium (in Whitechurch). These are naturally occurring materials but can present health risks to some individuals. Report a Problem

If you have a problem to report such as a streetlight out, pothole, tree trimming or removal, snow removal issues, dogs at large, etc. please let us know. Taxes

Property taxes are due on the first business day of March, June, September, and December. Late payments are subject to a penalty of 1.25 % per month.
