

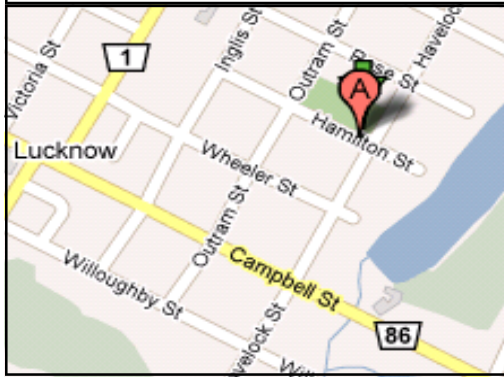

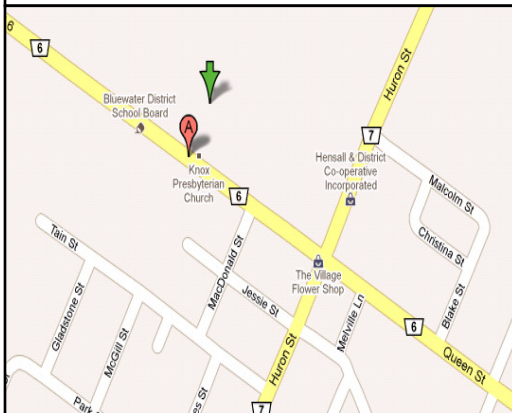
Play can happen anywhere and does not require special facilities or organization.

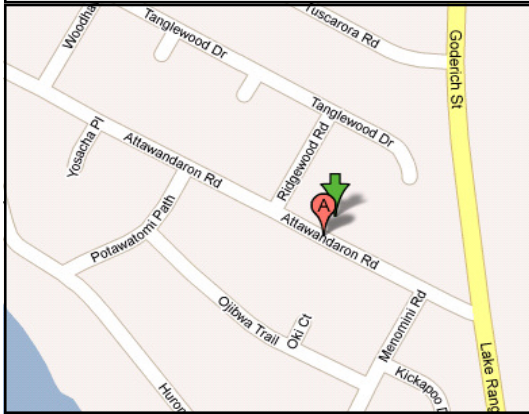

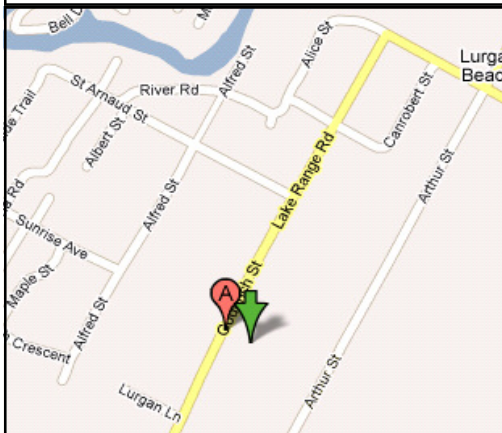


Play is spontaneous, accessible to all and low cost/free.

Basketball Court at the Point Clark Community Centre.



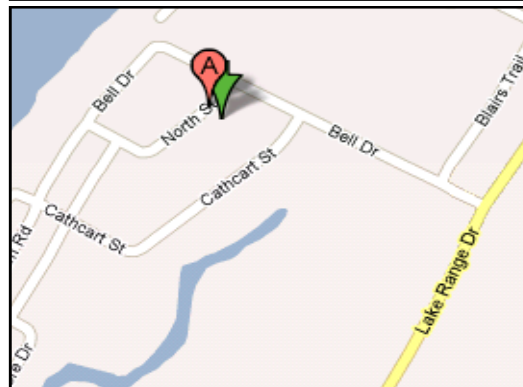

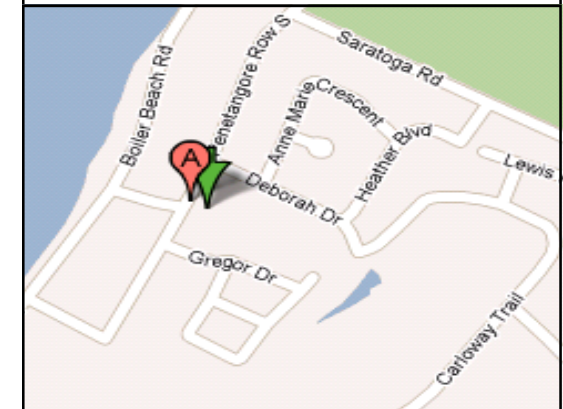
