



# The Township of Huron-Kinloss

**Municipal Election Day is Monday, October 27th, 2014**

The Township of Huron-Kinloss has for the second time chosen an Electronic method of election. Electors can choose to vote either by **telephone** or **Internet**.

- Electronic voting provides **flexibility** for where and when you vote.
- Each individual on the **Voters List** will receive a **Voter Information Letter**. This letter will contain instructions on how to cast your ballot and a PIN number to access the system.
- The **Voter Information Letter** will contain a phone number and location of the **Voter Help Centre** as well as candidate information.
- **Voter Information Letters** will be mailed out to qualified electors in October.

## [ Voting Period ]

You will be able to access the system to place your vote by telephone or internet from your home computer, telephone or smart phone starting on;

**October 20th, 2014 at 8:30a.m. to**

**October 27th, 2014 at 8:00p.m.**

## [ Voter Eligibility ]

To be an eligible elector in the Township of Huron-Kinloss, you have to be:

- a Canadian Citizen
- at least 18 years old on Election Day
- a resident of the Township of Huron-Kinloss, or the owner or tenant of land in the Township of Huron-Kinloss, or the spouse of such owner or tenant; and
- not prohibited from voting under any law

The Township of Huron-Kinloss has a seven member Council with; 1 Mayor, 1 Deputy Mayor and five councillors. Nomination period runs through to **September 12th, 2014 at 2:00pm.**

## Voter Help Centre/ Voting Place

A **Voter Help Centre/ Voting Place** will be located at the Municipal Office located at 21 Queen Street, Ripley. A voting station with telephone and internet access will be available.

Eligible electors and those who require assistance may vote electronically at the Municipal Office during the **Voting Period**. There will be no paper ballots available.

Election Officials will be available to assist:

**Monday, October 20th - Friday, October 24th**  
**8:30a.m. - 4:30p.m.**

**Saturday, October 25th 8:30a.m.- 8:00p.m.**

**Sunday, October 26th 10:00a.m. - 4:00p.m.**

**Monday, October 27th 8:30a.m. - 8:00p.m.**

The voting stations at the Municipal Office will be designed with accessibility features that will serve those residents having specific needs.

Internet access will also be provided free of charge at the Lucknow and Ripley libraries throughout the **Voting Period**. Voting assistance will not be provided at the libraries.

During the hours noted above a voter can speak with an election official to assist with voting by either telephone or internet or simply answer questions regarding the process.

## Voters' List & Revision Period

Eligible to vote? Visit [www.voterlookup.ca](http://www.voterlookup.ca) *now* to confirm if you are on the Preliminary List of Electors used to prepare the final **Voters List**.

The **Voters List** will be made available on September 2nd, 2014 at the Municipal Office and the Lucknow and Ripley Libraries. It is your responsibility to ensure your name is on the **Voters List**. If your information has recently changed please visit the Municipal Office in Ripley to complete a Revision Form or

Call the Township at 519-395-3735 to request a revision form by mail. Allow sufficient time for return mail.

The Revision Period starts September 2nd through to October 27th at 8:00p.m.
