

COUNTY OF BRUCE AND TOWNSHIP OF HURON-KINLOSS MUNICIPAL CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT WEST LUCKNOW STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS

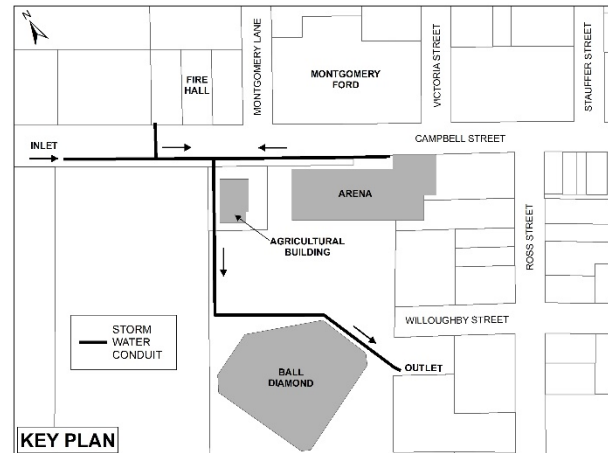
NOTICE OF COMPLETION

THE PROJECT: The County of Bruce and Township of Huron-Kinloss initiated a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) process to investigate alternative solutions for improving stormwater drainage along Campbell Street, west of Ross Street in Lucknow. The Class EA process investigated solutions to address the current ponding issues and continued use of the stormwater conduit beneath the Lucknow and District Sports Complex. From the investigation, **the following preferred solution has been selected and is shown in the included key figure: Convey stormwater to a new conduit west of the arena, then south and east to the outlet.**

ROAD IMPROVEMENTS: The above-noted EA investigation was undertaken in conjunction with the County's proposed rehabilitation of Campbell Street from Havelock Street to Victoria Street, and reconstruction west of Victoria Street. Campbell Street between Havelock and Victoria will be milled and resurfaced, while the section west of Victoria Street to the village limit will be reconstructed with tapers, curb and gutter and sidewalks. Additionally, a section of Ross Street between Campbell Street and Clyde Street will be rehabilitated.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCREENING PROCESS:

The project, as an activity subject to an environmental screening process, is following the planning process established for Schedule B activities under the Class EA document. The purpose of the Environmental Assessment process is to identify a preferred solution, identify any potential environmental impacts associated with the proposal and to plan for appropriate mitigation of those impacts. The process includes consultation with the public, stakeholders and government review agencies. The environmental assessment process has now been completed. There were no negative impacts identified with the project that could not be mitigated.



PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT:

An Environmental Screening Report will be available for public review at the Lucknow Public Library (526 Campbell St., Lucknow) and the Huron-Kinloss Municipal Office (21 Queen St., Ripley). If environmental concerns arise regarding this project, which cannot be resolved in discussion with the Municipality, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order that the project comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act, which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister, at the address below, within 30 calendar days of this Notice. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Municipality and Project Engineer at the addresses noted. If no such request is received by March 31, 2017, the project will proceed to implementation as planned.
