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## Notice of Open House for Official Plan Review

The Township of Huron-Kinloss is in the process of preparing an update to the Official Plan to guide the future of the Township to the year 2036. The Official Plan Review is scheduled to be completed in 2016.

As part of the Official Plan Review, a comprehensive review in accordance with the Provincial Policy Statement, 2014, has been completed to ensure that a 20-year supply of land is provided to accommodate projected growth. The comprehensive review recommends modifying settlement area boundaries and land use designations affecting some properties within the Township. There are no proposed changes to the Lakeshore Settlement Area Boundary as a result of the comprehensive review.

Any person may attend the Open House and/or make written or verbal representation either in support or in opposition to the proposed Official Plan. If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan, you must make a written request to Sonya Watson, Clerk.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Huron-Kinloss before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Council of the Township of Huron-Kinloss to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Township of Huron-Kinloss before the proposed Official Plan is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.
