We have received a request from the Ontario Convenience Stores Association (OCSA) regarding the distribution and sale of contraband (illegal) tobacco throughout Ontario.

CONTRABAND TOBACCO

WHEREAS Contraband tobacco has negative public consequences and impacts such as unrestricted youth access to tobacco products, and in increase in criminal activity; and

WHEREAS small businesses are sometimes forced to close because of the sale of contraband tobacco; and

WHEREAS small business in our community and government in general stand to benefit from the institution of tougher restrictions on contraband tobacco:

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that Huron-Kinloss Township Council hereby request the Ontario Minister of Finance support the Ontario Government's 2012 Budget commitments to eradicate contraband tobacco through the implementation of additional regulatory, enforcement and other provisions in Bill 186 and amendments to the Tobacco Tax Act. Particularity in support of measures such as:

- Increased fines for those convicted of offenses related to contraband tobacco;
- More authority for law enforcement officials with respect to: forfeiture of items seized, and impounding of vehicles;
- Drawing on the best practices of other jurisdictions and working collaboratively with the Federal Government and other jurisdictions to enhance contraband tobacco control through joint enforcement efforts; and

FURTHER THAT the Provincial Government be encouraged to continue to strengthen their strategies to address the manufacture and supply of contraband tobacco and maintain their commitment to introduce amendments this fall to implement these measures.
