MEETING NOTES

1.0 TOUR

- 1.1 Areas viewed and noted included the asphalt break up on Kairshea Avenue, proposed hydro pole re-locate at the railway walking trail on County Road 1, Kennedy Road watermain project, Community Living Building water connection, Concession 4 paving, and the area of last year's cottage removals.
- 1.2 Information viewing stops were made at the VanderHoek drain crossing on Concession 6, the Lucknow Town Hall elevator, and asphalt break up on Statters Lake Avenue.
- 1.3 An informal discussion took place regarding the future paving in Lucknow, and as explained by the Director of Public Works, while Willoughby, Outram and Ludgard are priorities, they are dependent on the water reserve, and that no gravel roads within the Township should be paved at the expense of losing an existing paved road.
- 1.4 Consensus was that the Director of Public Works should explore the possibility of (a) removing the stop sign at Saratoga Road and Lake Range Drive, and (b) speak with the Drainage Superintendent regarding the drainage issue on Sideroad 30, north of County Road 6.
- 1.5 There are no items to be brought forth for discussion at the next Council meeting.
- 1.6 A viewing of the Morrison's eco-friendly house was also scheduled, with all in attendance impressed by the design.
