Huron Landfill Hours

Effective September 8, 2020, the Huron Landfill, located at 2087 Concession Rd 6 E, Ripley will be open Tuesdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 10 am to 4 pm.

To help minimize the spread of COVID-19, we have implemented additional safety measures to protect both staff and the public. These procedures may cause delays at the site, please be patient and courteous.

- Brush will be permitted however we strongly encourage use of the temporary yard waste depots in Point Clark, Ripley and Lucknow (available until November 2020).
- We encourage residents to continue to use curbside pick-up for household garbage.

The Kinloss Landfill will be open Saturdays from 10 am to 2 pm until October 31, 2020.

The site only accepts brush, steel, white goods and recyclables, and is located at 690 Kairshea Avenue between Bruce Road 1 and Paradise Lake Street.

Huron-Kinloss Residents can Report Issues with New App

Residents can now download the SeeClickFix app for Huron-Kinloss, making reporting any non-emergency issues you see within the Township. This app allows residents to connect, stay up-to-date and initiate change in our community. SeeClickFix will launch August 31, 2020.

The SeeClickFix app for Huron-Kinloss is a community-driven communication tool and request management system that bridges the gap between residents and Township staff and allows for more community engagement.

Simply download the SeeClickFix app, report the problem and the appropriate staff member from the Township will address the issue or concern.

Face Covering Order Extended

The Grey Bruce Health Unit Medical Officer of Health, Dr. Ian Arra, renewed the Order requiring face coverings in indoor facilities, effective August 14, 2020 for an additional for 4 weeks.

This order includes Commercial Establishments in Grey Bruce, to the fullest extent possible for all the following, that they:

- Ensure effective measures are in place to maintain physical distancing of 2 metres amongst all employees and clients
- Ensure the availability of alcohol-based hand rub at all entrances and exits
- Make the best effort (verbal) to restrict persons from entering the premises or remaining within the premises if not wearing a face covering. Turning away or refusing a customer is not required under this Order.
