Huron-Kinloss Mayor Lifts State of Emergency

On November 1, 2021, Mayor Twolan, officially lifted the State of Emergency for the Township of Huron-Kinloss in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Township has been in a declared a State of Emergency since March 23, 2020. As the pandemic continues, and the community gradually reopens with standard operating procedures in place, the State of Emergency is no longer needed.

The health and safety of the residents of Huron-Kinloss still remains a top priority. The Township will continue to monitor the COVID-19 pandemic and make the necessary modifications to services as we adjust to living with the pandemic.

Despite taking this significant step, provincial orders remain in effect under the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act and the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act. This includes providing proof of full vaccination against COVID-19 and personal identification to access certain businesses and settings.

Municipal Office

The Huron-Kinloss Municipal Office will be closed starting at noon on Friday, December 24, 2021 and will reopen at 8:30am on Monday, January 3, 2022.

The Hub (46 Queen St., Ripley)

The Hub will be closed December 23, 2021 and will reopen on January 3, 2022.

Upcoming Vaccine Clinics in Ripley

The Grey Bruce Health Unit is hosting COVID-19 vaccine clinics at the Ripley-Huron Community Centre located at 17 Queen Street, Ripley on the following dates:

- **December 14th, 2021 from 12:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.**
- **January 3rd, 2022 from 12:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.**
- **January 12th, 2022 from 12:00 p.m. - 6:00p.m**
- **February 2nd, 2022 from 12:00 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.**

Eligible individuals will be able to book their third dose appointment through the COVID-19 Vaccination Portal [Ontario.ca/bookvaccine](https://ontario.ca/bookvaccine) or by calling the Provincial Vaccine Contact Centre at 1-833-943-3900.

You will not be able to get your 3rd dose without an appointment.

First and second doses of COVID-19 vaccine for those age 12 and older do not require an appointment.

All newly eligible groups must wait 6 months (168 days minimum) following their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine in order to be eligible for a third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. (example: If you got your second dose of your vaccine on June 1st, 2021, you are eligible for a booster dose on November 16th, 2021).

Proof of Vaccination Documents Requirements

The Township of Huron-Kinloss must be consistent with Provincial Regulations regarding COVID-19 vaccine policies. Patrons will need to be fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days) and provide their proof of vaccination along with photo ID to access certain public settings and facilities in Huron-Kinloss including:

- Ripley-Huron Community Centre
- Lucknow and District Sports Complex
- Lucknow Town Hall
- Point Clark Community Centre
