Township of Huron-Kinloss Recreation Facilities Close

The Ontario Government announced, the province will move into [Step Two of its Roadmap to Reopen](#), with modifications, effective January 5, 2022 at 12:01 a.m, due to the increase of COVID-19 hospitalizations.

As a result, all indoor recreation facilities in the Township of Huron-Kinloss will be closed until further notice. These facilities include:

- Ripley-Huron Community Centre
- Point Clark Community Centre
- Lucknow Town Hall
- Lucknow and District Sports Complex

Outdoor recreation amenities including public trails, playgrounds and the Point Clark Dog Park remain open.

The Hub, located at 46 Queen St. will be open by appointment only. Contact Lauren at leby@huronkinloss.com or 519-395-4225.

The Municipal Office, located at 21 Queen Street in Ripley, will remain open to the public with some staff working remotely. To help reduce the number of visitors to the Municipal Office, appointments with staff are encouraged by calling 519-395-3735 or email info@huronkinloss.com.
