

**Revocation Order under the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act***

Whereas the Mayor of the Township of Huron-Kinloss has declared that an emergency exists in the Township as a result of the existing COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant subsection 4(1) of *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. E.9, as amended (the "Act");

And whereas subsection 4(1) of the Act provides that the Mayor may take such actions and make such orders as the Mayor considers necessary to implement the Township's emergency plan and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Township;

And whereas the Township continues to strongly discourage all seasonal residents from travelling to the Township while the pandemic situation exists, and had on March 30, 2020 ordered that it would not permit the operation of valves for the purposes of supplying water to seasonal properties (the "Water Order");

And whereas the Mayor now wishes to revoke the Water Order while maintaining the declaration of emergency in place;

Now therefore the Mayor hereby makes the following Order under the authority of subsection 4(1) of the Act:

1. The Water Order is hereby revoked.
