Reflecting on the One Year Anniversary of the COVID-19 Pandemic in Huron-Kinloss

On March 23, 2020 Mayor Twolan declared a State of Emergency for the Township of Huron-Kinloss in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. With this declaration the Township invoked its emergency response plan. This included making adjustments to the way we provided services to our residents by modifying office and facilities procedures, shifting all Council meetings to virtual platform, offering alternative payment options and on-line building permit applications.

To support Huron-Kinloss businesses during the pandemic and respond to their needs, a map was created showing businesses that were open during the first Provincial Lockdown and added to the Bruce County wide Business Resiliency map. We developed a COVID-19 Business Support page on our website to help business owners navigate the federal, provincial, and local funding opportunities. Explore H-K was introduced to promote safe outdoor activities and local shopping.

Communications continue to keep the public informed with website updates, press releases, direct mailouts, electronic newsletters and a strong social media presence.

A big thank-you to our residents for their patience and understanding while we continue to make adjustments to the way we serve you during this monumental time.

Traveling Between Regions is Discouraged

As Grey-Bruce remains in a Green Stage of the COVID-19 Response Framework, Dr. Ian Arra, Grey-Bruce Medical Officer of Health is discouraging non-essential travel from region to region based on public health guidelines.

Essential reasons for travel include work, school or for medical reasons. Recreational, non-medical, social or leisure related reasons for travel are NOT be considered essential and are discouraged as per the provincial direction.
