Q: Is the Municipal Office open?

A: The Huron-Kinloss Municipal Office is currently open by appointment only. To book an appointment, phone 519-395-3735 or email info@huronkinloss.com. The Hub, located at 46 Queen St., Ripley, is open by appointment only. Please contact leby@huronkinloss.com

Q: Is the Ripley-Huron Community Centre open?

A: No. The Ripley-Huron Community Centre is closed to the public until further notice. For questions, please contact myoung@huronkinloss.com or 519-395-2909.

Q: Are the Parks and Outdoor Playgrounds Open?

A: Outdoor recreational amenities including off-leash dog area, park benches, outdoor playgrounds, play structures or play equipment are open within the Township of Huron-Kinloss. However, outdoor sports facilities and multi-use fields including ball diamonds, soccer fields, tennis courts, basketball courts and skate parks remain CLOSED until further notice.

Q: Are the Huron and Kinloss Landfills Open?

A: Yes. The Huron Landfill, located at 2087 Concession 6 East, is open Tuesday, Friday and Saturday from 10am to 4pm. The Kinloss Landfill, located at 690 Kairshea Ave. is open Saturdays 10am to 2pm.

Q: Will there be Yard Waste Depots?

A: Yes. There are two Yard Waste Depots. One is located beside the Huron Landfill, opening mid-May and the other is beside the entrance to the Lucknow Soccer Fields, located at 790 Havelock St, Lucknow and is now open.

Grey-Bruce COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Booking

Ontario prioritizes vaccine and determines eligible groups based on risk. Specific age groups can book a COVID-19 vaccination appointment through the provincial on-line booking system.
