## Huron and Kinloss Landfills Now Open to the Public

Both the Huron Landfill and the Kinloss Landfill are open to the public. The Kinloss Landfill site, located at 690 Kairshea Avenue, between Bruce Road 1 and Paradise Lake Street, is open Saturdays from 10 am to 2 pm. The site only accepts brush, steel, appliances with CFC removal tags where required (a CFC tag is proof of removal of freon from refrigerators, freezers, de-humidifiers and air conditioners), and recyclables.

The Huron Landfill, located at 2087 Concession 6 E, is open Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 10am to 4pm.

To help minimize the spread of COVID-19, we have implemented additional safety measures to protect both staff and the public.

- The methods of payment will be on-account or debit, using the tap option.
- There will be a limit of five vehicles permitted on-site at one time to ensure physical distancing.
- Brush will be permitted; however we strongly encourage use of the temporary yard waste depots in Point Clark, Ripley and Lucknow.
- We encourage residents to continue to use curbside pick-up for household garbage

For the curb-side garbage and recycling schedule or to sign-up for notifications visit Bruce Area Recycling.

The Huron Landfill Free Dump Day in June has been **Permanently Discontinued**.

Temporary Yard Waste Disposal Sites are available to dispose of brush, leaves, branches and grass clippings.

Yard Waste Disposal sites are located at:

- Lucknow - 907 Havelock St.; south of the Soccer Fields
- Ripley - 17 Queen St.; beside the tennis courts.
- Point Clark - 344 Lake Range Dr.; south of the cardboard recycling bins

## Funding Available to Support Continuing Education

The Township of Huron-Kinloss is offering funding to support our residents who choose to continue their education. The Early Investment in Education and Skills program was developed to help off-set the financial costs associated with taking courses to further education.

Successful applicants are eligible to receive 50% of their course registration fee up to \$1,000. Course materials such as books, tools, etc, can also be included in the application.

- Applicants must be a resident of the Township of Huron-Kinloss.
- Course options may include, but not limited to: Project Management, computer literacy and skills, customer service, bookkeeping, political government courses, chef apprenticeship course, etc.
- Pre-approval of your application is required; Proof of course completion is required.
- Limited funds are available.

## Beaches and Outdoor Park Facilities Now Open in H-K

The Township of Huron-Kinloss has re-opened beaches, outdoor sports facilities and dog park. Outdoor sports facilities and multi-use fields are now open for casual use only, including:

- Baseball diamonds
- Soccer fields
- Basketball courts
- Skate parks
- Shooting ranges, including those operated by rod and gun clubs
- Tennis courts - Team play or doubles matches are not permitted unless participants are from the same households.

**Note: Outdoor playground structures remain CLOSED.**

Emergency Provincial Orders remain in place prohibiting gatherings of more than 10 people. This applies to all public use of opened outdoor park facilities.

The Point Clark off-leash dog park is now open. Please remember that the gates at off-leash dog parks are high touch-points that are not cleaned. Users should bring their own hand sanitizer and wash their hands before entering and after exiting a dog park.

### Canada Day Fireworks Cancelled

Our priority is the health and safety of our residents and to further eliminate the spread of COVID-19, the Township of Huron-Kinloss has decided to cancel the Point Clark Fireworks on July 1.
