BY-LAW

2020-23

Being a By-Law to Establish Rates and Fees for Services Performed by the Township of Huron-Kinloss

WHEREAS Section 391 (1) of the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on persons, for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or any local board; and for the use of its property including property under its control.

AND WHEREAS municipal Councils have the authority to establish rates and fees under various acts;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That the Township of Huron-Kinloss hereby establishes the rates and fees for services described in Schedules 'A' to 'O' attached hereto and forming part of this By-Law.
- 2.0 That By-Law No. 2019-20, By-Law No. 2019-84, and By-Law No. 2018-48 be hereby repealed.
- 3.0 This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 4.0 That all fees are effective upon passage unless specified otherwise.
- 5.0 That the By-Law may be cited as the "2020 Consolidated Rates and Fees By-Law".
