BY-LAW

2018-169

Being a by-law to establish remuneration rates for Council and Police Services Board representatives for the Township of Huron-Kinloss

WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it expedient to establish pay rates for Council and Police Services Board representatives;

AND WHEREAS an annual stipend is meant to compensate members for those non-meeting activities, events and incidental expenses that result from election to municipal office;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss enacts as follows:

- 1.0 That the Mayor of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss shall receive an annual stipend of \$14,909.07 for 2019 and \$15,348.89 for 2020.
- 2.0 That the Deputy Mayor of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss shall receive an annual stipend of \$9,673.41 for 2019 and \$9,958.78 for 2020.
- 3.0 That Councillors of The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss shall receive an annual stipend of \$7,412.85 for 2019 and \$7,631.53 for 2020.
- 4.0 In addition to the stipend, each member of Council, including the Mayor and Deputy Mayor shall receive payment in the amount of \$184.89 in 2019 and \$190.35 in 2020 for each Council, Committee of the Whole, Standing Committee and Special meeting or attendance at the municipal office for which the member was present.
- 5.0 If any member of Council is authorized to attend Committee meetings where remuneration is paid directly by that organization, the member shall be entitled to receive any difference between the rate of remuneration of that organization and the rate referred to in Section 4.0.
- 6.0 The Council per diem rate shall be \$184.89 for 2019 and \$190.35 for 2020.
- 7.0 The annual remuneration payable to the Local Representative and the Provincial Representative of the Police Services Board is \$250.00 for 2019 and 2020.
- 8.0 This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passage.
- 9.0 This by-law may be cited as the "Council and Police Services Board Remuneration By-Law".

READ a THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 17th day of December, 2018.
