By-Laws / Permits

Fire Permits

Fire permit renewal invoices have been mailed out. Any permits not paid for by the due date will be cancelled. Fire permits are required for Open Air Burning and beach fires. You must report all Open Air Burning to our toll free 24/7

Winter Parking By-Law

Residents are reminded that the Traffic and Parking By-Law 99-20 as amended states that parking is not allowed on any street within the Township between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 30th.

Dog Tags

All dogs within the Township must be registered and wear their Huron-Kinloss dog tag for identification. Dogs that are found not wearing a tag are transported to the Township pound. To recover your dog, there is a reclaim fee, pound fees and other penalties that may need to be paid. To renew or register a new dog, there is an online form for your convenience at https://www.huronkinloss.com/live-here/animal-services/. Dog tags can be paid for and purchased at: Country Depot in Kincardine, Hodgins' Home Hardware in Lucknow, the Township Office in Ripley as well as online through the Township website. The cost for a dog tag is \$25.00.

Noise Exemption

Persons having functions where loud noise will occur after 11:00 p.m. need to apply for an exemption to the Noise By-Law 2005-101 by submitting a letter to the Clerk's Department at least 6 weeks prior to the event. Fireworks are only permitted for Canada Day or Victoria Day celebrations and will need an exemption to be detonated at any other time.

Public Works

Garbage Collection

All garbage bags must be sealed, not weigh more than 18kg (40lbs), and have a Huron-Kinloss bag tag sticker. The price of bag tags is \$3.00 and may be purchased at the Township office and various local retailers.

Landfill Sites

<u>Huron Landfill Site</u> – 2087 Concession 6 East Open Tuesdays, Fridays, Saturdays 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Closed: Fri. April 18 and Sat. April 19, 2025, for Easter.

Did you know that Huron Landfill recycles the following:

- Bale wrap
- Electronics & batteries (no car batteries)
- Expanded polystyrene (dense Styrofoam that is found in appliance and electronics packaging, NOT insulation or food packaging)
- Household recyclables, tires

- Mattresses and box springs for a fee
- Scrap steel and appliances (freon must be removed and CFC tagged)

As per the Huron Landfill site Certificate of Approval and Waste Management By-Law 2011-09, the Township is only able to accept materials from Township sources. Proof of Residence or Source is required when disposing of items at the landfill site.

Yard Waste Depots

<u>2083 Concession 6 E</u> – Just east of Huron Landfill <u>907 Havelock St Lucknow</u> – Just south of soccer fields

Open seasonally from mid-April to mid-November, weather dependent. These depots will be open to the public 24/7 during this time frame. Yard Waste Depots will accept bagged leaves, grass, brush, and small branches (under 6" in diameter). No logs or stumps!

Water Management

Starting January 1, 2025, the Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA) will become the Operating Authority for water and wastewater systems in Huron-Kinloss, continuing the delivery of clean and safe drinking water. We thank Veolia for nearly 20 years of dedicated service and look forward to a long-term partnership with OCWA. Learn more at www.ocwa.com. Our Water System Operators require at least 48 hours' notice to turn water off/on. Please call the Township office if this service is required. The owner/plumber must be present when turning water on to avoid leaks and possible damage. There is no fee for this service.

Flushing occurs in the spring and fall and is an ongoing part of water system management. If you experience low pressure or discoloured water during that time, please flush the lines in your house for 20 minutes to clear your system. The Township highly recommends that all residents install back flow preventers on all outside taps.

Roads

If you have a problem to report such as a streetlight out, pothole, tree trimming or removal, snow removal issues, dogs at large, etc. please let us know. You may report these issues at any time through our website by clicking Report a Problem at the top right of each webpage, or download the Huron-Kinloss Connects mobile app.

<u>Taxes</u>

Property taxes are due on the first business day of March, June, September, and December. Late payments are subject to a penalty of 1.25% per month.
