Ontario's new Blue Box program makes recycling easier than ever. The same materials can be recycled in all communities creating an efficient province-wide system. In Huron-Kinloss, we are required to sort items into two boxes for proper processing, one for Containers and one for Fibres.

Food and cosmetic containers, beverage containers.

Empty and free from food residue.



Metal

Aerosol containers, food cans, metal lids, beverage cans.

Plastic containers

Empty and free from food residue.

Flexible plastic packaging

Bread bags, dry cleaning bags, snack wrappers, bubble wrap.



Empty and free from food residue.



Paper laminate packaging

Pet food bags, food service paper bags, and plates.

Municipal Election 2026



The next municipal and school board election will take place on October 26, 2026.

As in previous elections, the 2026 municipal and school board election will use telephone and internet voting methods. Election related information will be updated at www.huronkinloss/election

Am I eligible to vote?

Anyone can vote in a municipal election who, on the day of the election:

- (a) resides in the local municipality or is the owner or tenant of land there, or the spouse of such owner or tenant;
- (b) is a Canadian citizen;
- (c) is at least 18 years old; and
- (d) is not otherwise prohibited from voting by law.

Note: You cannot vote as a corporation or as a person acting as an executor or trustee or in any other representative capacity for another person.

How do I register to vote?

New for 2026: - Voters can now manage their information for provincial, municipal, and school board elections in one place.

Visit vreg.registertovoteon.ca/en/home to confirm, update, or add your information.

If your school board support has changed, contact the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation at www.mpac.ca/schoolsupport.

Is my information up to date?

Because of changes to how the voters' list is prepared, you may not currently be registered — even if you have voted before.

Please confirm or register before August 1, 2026.

It is especially important for you to confirm your information as soon as possible if you are:

- a tenant or the spouse of a tenant residing in the Township,
- one of multiple owners, or the spouse of one of multiple owners of a property; or
- a dependent student studying away, but whose permanent address is in the Township of Huron-Kinloss.

How do I cast my vote?

Voter Information Letters (VIL) will be mailed to all registered eligible voters in October. These letters will contain your voting credentials and instructions on how to cast your ballot electronically.

To receive your VIL by mail, you will need to be a registered voter on the preliminary list of electors. If you did not receive your VIL and would like to vote, details will be available on the municipal website.

During the Voting Period, a Voter Help Centre/ Voting Place will be set up at the Municipal Office, located at 21 Queen St., Ripley. There will be no paper ballots available for the municipal election.

Staff will be available to provide assistance or answer any questions.

Thinking of running for Council?

The Township of Huron-Kinloss has a 7-member Council, elected at-large. Every eligible elector may select candidates for the following offices:

- Mayor (1)
- Deputy Mayor (1)
- Councillor Member (5)

School Board Trustees may also be included on the ballot for the English Public, English Separate, French Public, and French Separate school boards.

Nominations for the Municipal and School Board Election will be accepted at the Municipal Office during regular office hours beginning May 1, 2026.

To become an eligible candidate, you must be an eligible elector for the office which you seek and must not be prohibited from voting or disqualified by any legislations from holding public office.

Registration for the 2026 Golf Car season is open!



Golf cars must be registered in the Golf Car Pilot Project and have a Registration Sticker and a current Validation Sticker to participate and to drive a golf car within the Township.

Golf cars are only permitted on municipal roads with a maximum speed of 50Km per hour or less. Golf cars may operate April 1st to November 30th each year.

Golf Cars are regulated under the Highway Traffic Act.

MPAC Property Assessments

MPAC determines property assessments for all properties in Ontario. Municipalities determine revenue requirements, set municipal tax rates and collect property taxes to pay for municipal services. The Government of Ontario establishes the province's assessment and taxation laws and determines education tax rates.

The Ontario government postponed the 2020 Assessment Update due to the Covid-19 pandemic. On August 16, 2023, the Ontario government filed a regulation to amend the Assessment Act, extending the postponement of a province-wide reassessment through the end of the 2021-2024 assessment cycle. Property assessments for the 2026 property tax year will continue to be based on fully phased-in January 1, 2016 current values. This means your property assessment for the 2026 property tax year will be the same as the 2025 tax year, unless there have been changes to your property.

We are continuously reviewing properties. You may have received a Notice for one of the following reasons:

- change to property ownership, legal description, or school support;
- change to the property's value resulting from a Request for Reconsideration, an Assessment Review Board decision, or ongoing property reviews;
- property value increase/decrease reflecting a change to the property; for example, a new structure, addition, or removal of an old structure; or
- change in the classification or tax liability of the property.

Fire Safety

The Fire Stations within the Township of Huron-Kinloss are dedicated to providing emergency fire response, fire prevention, and public education

Fire Permits & Burn Complaints

Fire permits are issued annually for open-air and beach fires. Recreational fires (campfires) do not require a permit. Applications are available on the Township website or at the municipal office. Please review the amended Open-Air Burning by-law for more information or visit the open-air burning section of the website.

To report a non-emergency burn complaint, call 1-833-757-7539. For any active fire threat to life or property, call 911 immediately.

Emergency Planning & Preparedness

Be prepared and have a plan for every season.

- **Stay informed:** Sign up for weather alerts from Environment & Climate Change Canada.
- **Build an emergency kit:** Have an emergency kit filled with items that anyone in your family (including pets) may need for at least 72hrs, this will look different for everyone.
- **Community Care:** Please check on your neighbours during an emergency especially anyone new to the area, kids and seniors.

Woodstove & Fireplace Safety

- **Use Safe Fuel:** Burn only dry, seasoned wood; avoid wet/green wood and never burn garbage, plastic, or chemically treated wood.
- **Maintain Clearances:** Keep combustibles (furniture, drapes, rugs) at least 3 feet away from the stove and flue pipe.
- **Clean Regularly:** Have your chimney and stovepipe cleaned annually (or more often) to remove creosote buildup.
- **Schedule Inspections:** Have a qualified professional inspect your stove and chimney each year for wear or damage.
- **Dispose of Ashes Safely:** Place ashes in a covered metal container at least 10 feet from buildings or decks. Let them cool for several days before disposal.

Fire Detection

Smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarms save lives when installed and maintained properly.

- **Install Alarms:** Install smoke and CO alarms on every level of your home and outside all sleeping areas.
- **Test Monthly:** Press the test button on all alarms once a month and replace batteries as needed.
- **Replace Expired Units:** Check the manufacture or expiry date and replace alarms that are 10 years old or older.

Home and Yard Fire Prevention

- **Create a Safety Zone:** Maintain a 1.5-metre (5-foot) non-combustible space around your home and deck.
- **Keep Areas Clean:** Clear gutters, roofs, decks, and balconies of leaves, needles, and debris.
- **Remove Surface Fuels:** Regularly clean up fallen branches, dry grass, and other natural debris.
- **Store Firewood Safely:** Keep firewood at least 10 metres (30 feet) from your home and remove combustible materials from under decks.
- **Use Non-Combustible Materials:** Create fire breaks using gravel, brick, concrete, or mineral soil.
- **Landscape Wisely:** Avoid woody shrubs or trees within 1.5 metres (5 feet) of your home. If present, prune and maintain them.
- **Choose Safer Building Materials:** Select non-combustible materials when building or renovating.
- **Handle Flammable Liquids Safely:** Store all flammable liquids away from heat sources.

In the event of an emergency, call 911.

Ensure every member of your household (including guests at seasonal cottages) knows your 911/civic address and that it is clearly visible from the road.

Garbage, Recycling & Household Waste

The Township of Huron-Kinloss is an environmentally conscious community that is a good steward of our natural environment by using our resources wisely, being aware, and taking responsibility. We have many programs to help support a healthy environment.

Household Services

Garbage Collection Services

Garbage collection in Huron-Kinloss is provided by Bruce Area Solid Waste Recycling (BASWR) and is provided weekly.

All garbage bags must weigh no more than 18 kg (40 lbs), be securely tied or sealed, and be placed at the curb by 8:00 a.m. on your collection day. Each bag must also have a Huron-Kinloss bag tag attached.

Bag tags cost \$3.00 and can be purchased at the Municipal Office or from local retailers in Amberley, Holyrood, Kincardine, Lucknow, and Ripley. A full list of participating retailers is available at www.huronkinloss.com/garbage-and-recycling.

Blue Box Collection Services

As of January 1, 2026, all municipalities in Ontario have transitioned to the province's producer-operated recycling system. Under this model, recycling collection is fully funded by producers of recyclable materials. The new system aims to reduce waste and standardize recycling across Ontario.



Residential properties in Huron-Kinloss will continue to receive curbside Blue Box collection, The frequency of collection and your collection day will remain the same. Refer to the collection map and schedule for details. You can now recycle more materials than before, including corrugated cardboard. Blue Box materials must be sorted into two streams: Containers and Fibres. Sorting guidelines are available on Page 42 of this guide.

Extra Blue Boxes can be purchased at the Municipal Office, the Huron Landfill or from BASWR at 126 Concession Rd 14, Southampton. Please note that due to new provincial requirements, cardboard depots in Point Clark, Lucknow, and Ripley have been removed.

Items Eligible for Free Recycling Drop-Off at Huron Landfill

The following items are collected for free at the Huron Landfill, 2087 Concession 6 East, Ripley

- E-waste (Don't forget to remove or wipe personal data before drop-off!)
- Household batteries (no car or lead-acid batteries)
- Yard waste (brush, leaves, branches, and grass clippings)
- Steel and white goods (appliances must have required CFC removal tags)
- Tires (except large tractor tires)

Huron Landfill Recycling Depot

The Huron Landfill also offers both a Commercial and a Residential Recycling Depot primarily for those without curbside Blue Box collection:

- The Commercial Depot is open Mondays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for business use.
- The Residential Depot is intended for households that do not receive curbside Blue Box collection. To help manage site capacity, residents with curbside service should use their home collection and only use this depot as an occasional backup. Open during regular landfill hours.

Agricultural Plastics

The Huron Landfill now accepts agricultural plastic waste, including bale wrap, bunker wrap, white greenhouse poly, boat wrap, and baler twine. You can pick up recycling bags at the landfill free of charge. Clean the wrap, sort materials into separate bags, and return them for recycling. Fees are based on weight and charged at \$140 per tonne.

Yard Waste Depots

2083 Concession 6 East, Ripley
and 907 Havelock Street, Lucknow

Open seasonally from mid-April to mid-November, weather dependent. These depots will be open to the public 24/7 during this time frame. Yard Waste Depots will accept bagged leaves/grass/garden clipping, brush, and small branches under 6". No logs or stumps! Large dump loads should be taken to the landfill on the days it is open.

Green Cone Digesters

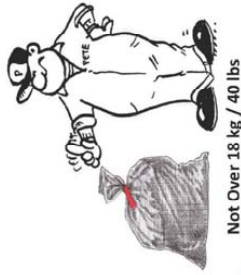
Green Cones are in-ground digesters that break down ALL food scraps, including meat, bones and dairy. This will not only cut down on the waste that goes to the landfill but also your personal household collection expense. It's a win-win for the environment and for you! Green Cone Digesters are available for purchase at the Municipal Office or Landfill for the subsidized cost of \$54.60 + HST.

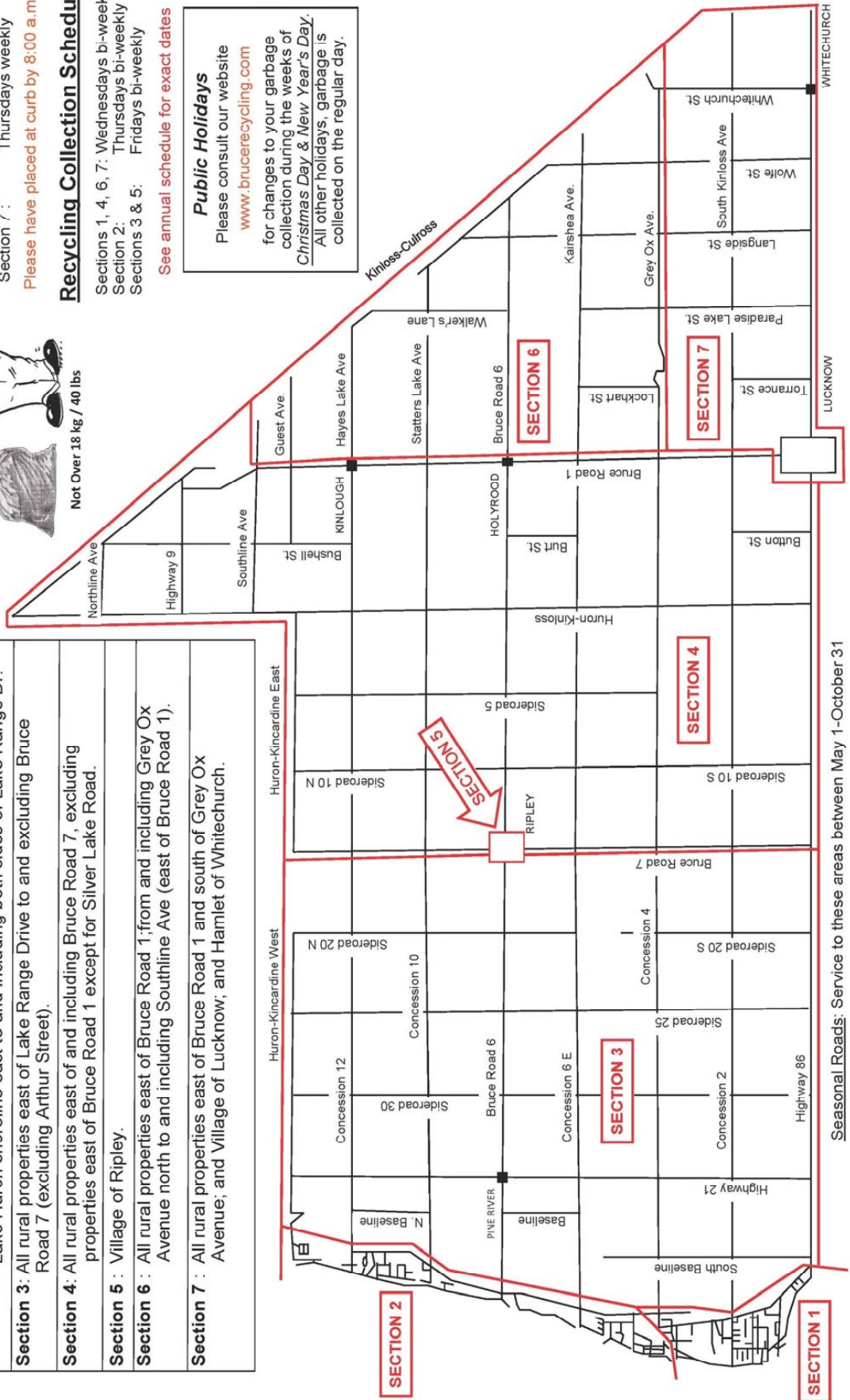

Safe Drinking Water

Water Source

The Township of Huron-Kinloss is fortunate to have ground-source water systems to deliver safe drinking water to all residents according to the Safe Drinking Water Act. Our water source does indicate presence of Sodium, Fluoride, and Barium (in Whitechurch). These are naturally occurring materials but can present health risks to some individuals. Please see our website under the Live Here/Water, Wastewater & Utilities tab for data and information or contact Grey Bruce Public Health at 1-800-263-3456 for more information.

Water Services

Are you a seasonal resident? If you need your water turned on/off please provide at least 2 days notice to schedule. The homeowner or delegate MUST be on premises when the water is turned on to prevent possible damage due to leaks.

Water Issues

If you are getting yellow or brown water from a tap that is used regularly, please flush your home system by opening an outside tap or bathtub faucet and running cold water for at least 20 minutes or until the water clears. If it does not clear, have a plumber check your hot water heater for possible sediment.

If you have low water pressure, first check your own home system including inline water filters, water softener, and water heater.

If your issue persists, call the Municipal office at 519-395-3735 during regular business hours or the emergency line at 1-866-299-5199 for after hour calls.

Municipal Roads

Public Works maintains approximately 396 km of roadway: 196 km asphalt surfaces, 169 km gravel, and 31 km tar & chip as well as the 104 bridges/structures and 14.8km of sidewalk.

By-Laws & Regulatory Information

The Township's By-Law Enforcement Officer is responsible for enforcing by-laws passed by Council to support public health, safety, and well-being while protecting persons and property. Frequently requested Township by-laws can be accessed online at <https://www.huronkinloss.com/town-hall/by-laws/>

Township By-Law Q&A

Q: What is the Township's Administrative Monetary Penalty System (AMPS)?

A: AMPS allows by-law related offences to be heard by the Township using independent Screening and Hearing Officers for hearings. The system is a fair and efficient process that relieves provincial court system of its time spent on by-law related offences.

Q: Are business advertisement signs permitted to be placed on the Township's road allowance?

A: As per the Township's Sign By-law, signs are not to be attached to trees, hydro or Township poles or support, or on Township or public property without permission from the Township. Business owners who are in violation of the sign by-law could receive a monetary penalty amount of \$300 per violation.

Q: How does the Noise By-Law pertain to me?

A: General noise must be minimized between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. the next day (9:00 a.m. on Sundays). Every homeowner should be mindful of neighbouring residents and properties at all times to not disturb the natural enjoyment of their properties. This includes persistent barking or whining of domestic pets.

If you are hosting a celebration or gathering, exemptions to the Noise By-law can be requested through Council. You must apply in writing to council at least 6 weeks in advance of the function. Contact the Clerks department at info@huronkinloss.com for further details.

Q: When can I have a family fireworks display?

A: According to our Noise Control By-Law 2005-101, the detonation of fireworks is prohibited in a residential area except in association with Victoria Day and/or Canada Day celebrations. All family members, tenants and renters visiting property in Huron-Kinloss should be made aware of these restrictions.

Q: When am I permitted to water my lawn?

A: The Lawn Watering By-Law No. 2010-46 is in effect from June 1 to Sept. 15 annually. Lawn watering is permitted based on your house number. Even numbered houses may water on even numbered days and odd numbered houses water on odd days of the month. Watering is permitted between 6 and 9 a.m. and 6 and 9 p.m. unless you use an automated sprinkler system, which must be set to run between 4 and 7 a.m. on the property's respective day. Financial penalties will be issued for those in contravention.

Township By-Law Q&A Continued

Q: Are chickens and other agricultural animals/livestock allowed on a residentially zoned property?

A: Chickens and other agricultural animals are only permitted to be located on Agricultural properties according to the Comprehensive Zoning By-Law 2018-98, as amended. This means that if your property is zoned residential or within an urban settlement area, you are NOT permitted to have chickens or other agricultural animals on the property.

Q: A neighbour's yard has grass and weeds growing more than fifteen (15) cm (6") in height. Is there anything the Township can do to have it cleaned up?

A: The Township of Huron-Kinloss has the Clean and Clear Yards By-Law No. 2023-60, which deals with non-maintained residential yards. This by-law sets out the minimum standards in which a property must be kept. These health and safety guidelines are in place to protect neighbours as well as the property owners.

Q: What is Giant Hogweed and what should I do with it?

A: Giant Hogweed is designated as a noxious weed in accordance with the Weed Control Act, R.S.O. 1990 and falls under the Clean and Clear Yards By-Law No. 2023-60. It is very hazardous to human health, if the stem oils meet human skin, it may cause severe burns. If an established growth is found on your property, it is recommended that a contractor be hired to remove the growth. Alternatively, if the growth is found at another location, please contact the Township.

Q: I have a raccoon/skunk hanging around my property. What can I do to get rid of it?

A: The Township of Huron-Kinloss does not deal with nuisance wildlife. We can provide the names of local trappers and/or private nuisance animal companies that will remove the animal for you at your expense.

Q: Does the Township have any regulations regarding the waterfront and beachfront area?

A: The Township of Huron-Kinloss has entered an agreement with the Ministry of Natural Resources to help protect our lakeshore. The following regulations are enforced along the public beachfront:

- No dogs shall be off leash,
- No littering and must clean up after pets,
- No motorized vehicles including golf carts or golf cars on the beach,
- Shall not alter or destroy sand dunes or create water crossing on road,
- Shall not remove any vegetation,
- Shall not burn any substance without obtaining a burn permit,
- Shall not construct or place any structure on the beach, and
- Shall not dredge and fill shoreline.

Q: Are there regulations to aid with snow removal and alleviate safety concerns during the winter months?

















A: According to the Township of Huron-Kinloss Parking Control By-Law No. 99-20, one must not be parked on a highway or a boulevard between Nov. 1 and April 30, between the hours of 1 and 6 a.m., to ensure roadways get cleared of snow properly.

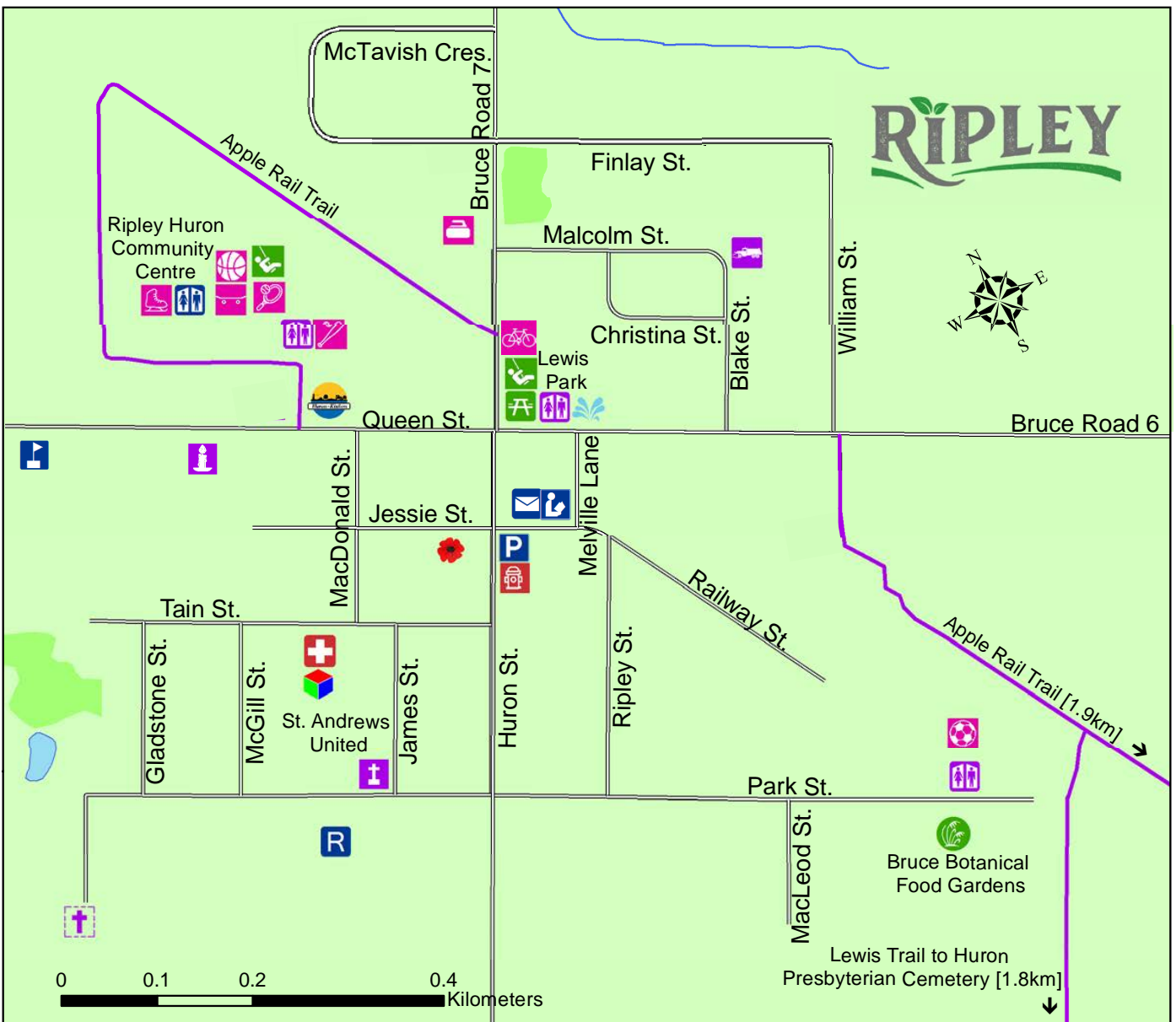
